

Dear Casa Linda Homeowners,

As you may know the Dominican Republic is having one of the driest “dry seasons” in history. Earlier this season the dry conditions mostly impacted southern regions of the country, however more recently the North shore has also been feeling the effects.

In the past few weeks two water pumps failed from overuse and while the pumps have since been replaced we need to adopt more preventative measures. This includes a reduction in pump running time to help safeguard their good working order and to lengthen their overall lifespan.

In addition, we are requesting a reduction in the use of sprinklers and to only water dry areas directly using a hose in the early morning or early evening. Please also check for and have repaired any pool leaks. And for those still doing it, we ask that you not empty and refill your pool on a regular basis.
